

Dear ISU families,

As you may be aware, there are now confirmed COVID-19 cases in [Neu-Ulm](#) and schools in Biberach are closing.

We will continue with all the precautionary measures that we have in place and that have been communicated to you previously.

Please do be aware of the following points:

- We are and will continue to follow, all directives from the *Schulamt* and there are currently no plans to close schools in Neu-Ulm;
- A list of high-risk areas can be found on the [Robert Koch Institute website](#). The list of high-risk areas is constantly growing so please do check it regularly.
- Anyone who has travelled to high-risk areas needs to contact the health authorities **immediately** at *Bayerisches Landesamt für Gesundheit und Lebensmittelsicherheit (LGL) hotline at 09131 68085101*
- As communicated previously, anyone with a sore throat or symptoms of respiratory illness, with or without a fever, are asked to refrain from visiting the campus. If students are experiencing these symptoms, parents should inform us and keep their children at home until they feel better. If these symptoms persist, please do seek medical advice.
- Should we have to close the school, we do have provisions to continue learning online. I again ask any family that does not have internet access to contact me so we can make provisions;
- Our website has a list of resources and information that may prove useful to families.
