

Dear ISU Community,

These are the updated measures from the German government. These measures apply for all the states in Germany and come into effect on Monday, 23 March and apply for at least 2 weeks:

- Gatherings of more than 2 people are not allowed, exception: people who live in the same household
- Keep a distance to other people of 1.5 meters when in public
- Staying in a public room (e.g. ATM machine in a bank) is only allowed with one more person who does not live in the same household or with people living in the same household
- Going to work, grocery shopping, medical appointments, participation at exams or meetings, helping others, individual sports and walks outside are still allowed
- Visiting people in hospital, elderly homes, ... is not allowed
- All restaurants are closed, except for take-away and delivery service
- Service companies are closed (hair dressers, cosmetic studios, massage places, ...), however, medical treatment can continue
- The hygiene regulations have to be followed in all businesses, especially, if they are open to public.
