ISU does not offer a designated religion class.

The Schulamt in Neu-Ulm has notified ISU that schools in Bavaria normally offer a choice between Catholic, Protestant and Ethics classes, At ISU, the humanities programme and PSHE incorporates Ethics; this is the same arrangement provided at other international schools in Bavaria. However, the school is required to ensure that all parents sign to indicate their agreement with this arrangement.

Permission for SeeSaw

Our students in **EYP and Grades 1-5** will be using SeeSaw (<http://seesaw.me>), a secure online journal where students can document what they are learning in class. Your child will be able to add the things we work on (e. g. photos, videos, worksheets, drawings and voice recordings) to their SeeSaw journal and we can share them privately with you and other family members to view and comment on.

In order for your child to use SeeSaw, certain personally identifiable information – like the student's first name, photos, videos or voice recordings – may be collected.

SeeSaw has a robust privacy policy (<http://app.seesaw.me/about/privacy>) and is committed to never share or sell your child's personal information or journal content.

Seesaw's policy is in keeping with German Data Protection Laws and many international schools in German use this software to share and document students' learning.

In order for your child to use SeeSaw, we must provide you with notification and obtain your permission.

Google Suite Permission (Grades 6-12)

Google Suite includes features such as google drive, e-mail, calendar, docs, sheets and presentation which means that there will be no need for flash drives, conversion from Mac to PC, even saving since this can all be done automatically through the google applications.

Google Classroom makes searching online for videos, images, or information much safer since the school will have the capability to automatically select safe searching. Teachers will be able to direct their students to the websites, videos, and images that will help them in the classroom, but also at home. This will be a cloud-based system that can be accessed from any mobile device.

Google Classroom will also include school e-mail, google sites, and blogging – these features will be limited to the appropriate grade level. Students will easily be able to create a portfolio of their learning. Communication with the teacher and other students will be extremely convenient and simple. Parents can also access Google Classroom to see what the class is doing and see the work of their child(ren).

Permission for students to leave campus at lunch time, break time and during free periods - Grades 9 to 12

Students who are in Grades 9 and 10 are allowed to leave the school campus at lunch time.
Students who are in Grades 11 and 12 are allowed to leave the school campus at lunch time, break time and during free periods.

This permission is a privilege and not a right. The privilege may be sustained by following the criteria below:

- signing in and out of school
- behaving in an appropriate manner that does not damage the reputation of ISU
- abiding by the laws of the land and of the school
- coming back into school on time
- parents have given consent for the student to leave the school during lunch times
- not smoking on or nearby the campus (it is illegal to purchase cigarettes unless you are 18 years or older)

A breach of any of the above criteria will cause this allowance to be withdrawn, and may also be acted upon according to the school's Behaviour Policy.
